# Minneapolis Business Grants for Efficiency Upgrades

Center for Energy and Environment (CEE) is proud to partner with the City of Minneapolis to offer Green Cost Share grant funding for businesses.

Grants can cover **20% – 40% of the cost** (up to \$20,000) of eligible lighting, HVAC, or refrigeration upgrades on top of regular program rebates.

## How the program works

- Visit [mncee.org/GCS](https://mncee.org/GCS) to sign up for a free energy assessment for your business
- After the assessment, you'll receive a customized report with recommendations and estimated energy savings, grants, and rebates
- CEE will complete and submit all grant and rebate paperwork when your project is finished
- Projects must be completed between 1/1/25–12/31/25. Grants are available on a first come first served basis until funds are depleted
